In and around St. Augustine

Brunch abounds for guests staying in Historic Downtown St. Augustine. The Grand Easter Brunch at the upscale <u>Cordova</u> <u>Coastal Chophouse & Bar</u> is overflowing with culinary delights, including a grand seafood station, carvings stations, a bountiful dessert station, and more. Along the Beaches

On Vilano Beach, enjoy an elegant steak or seafood dinner at <u>Michael's</u> at Hyatt Place, pair it with a wine from their award-winning collection. Or enjoy the casual rooftop atmosphere at <u>Pesca at Vilano</u>, also located at Hyatt Place on Vilano.
